Passports, Visas and Vaccinations

Travellers are responsible for ensuring that they have a valid passport for travel to the relevant countries and that it is valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel. A visa is required for British passport holders visiting Jordan but not for Israel, details of how to obtain this will be sent with your final invoice. At the time this brochure went to press no vaccinations or inoculations are required for travel but you may wish to consult your own doctor for advice concerning this. If you have

Further Information And Paying The Balance

Further information will be sent to you regarding any action that may be required approximately 10 weeks before departure. A final invoice will also be sent at this time and the balance for the tour must be paid at least 8 weeks before departure.

Travel Information

Full travel information, including details of meeting points, flight times, accommodation and travel information, will be sent to you approximately 2 weeks before departure. Normally, tickets are not issued but are handed to you at the airport or departure point by our representative who will be there to ensure that you depart without a hitch and to deal with any last minute difficulties.

Travel Insurance

It is compulsory to have travel insurance for your booking. Holiday Extras have a range of policies available at very competitive prices. You can obtain a quote online by visiting www.chrisitan-travel.com or alternatively you can call 0871 360 2742 and quote ABTA number 93522.

Gratuities

Our normal procedure is to deal with tips on a group basis and these are included in the price. The tour leader will distribute them to the guide, driver and hotels on your behalf. Individual tipping is not recommended unless the circumstances are exceptional.

Room Check In and Check Out Times

The standard international practice is to let rooms from midday to midday. However times do vary. Check-in times are usually between 2pm and 3pm, check-out times between 11am and 12 noon on the day of departure. Therefore, if you check-in immediately after a night flight this would normally count as one night's accommodation. Similarly if your return flight is at night you will normally be required to vacate your room at 12 noon prior to leaving for the airport. Day rooms are subject to availability/cost and should be arranged locally with the accommodation management.

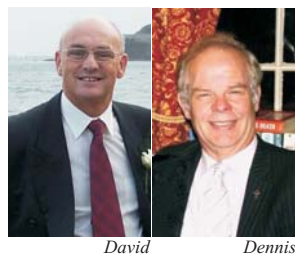

Day 1, Tuesday

We depart from London Heathrow on our flight to Tel Aviv. On arrival we will be met and transferred to our hotel in Netanya for dinner and overnight.

Day 2, Wednesday

We visit the amphitheatre and aqueduct at Caesarea and drive to Mount Carmel, the scene of Elijah’s conflict with the prophets of Baal. Continue to Jezreel and Mount Tabor for visits. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 3, Thursday

Today we drive to Caesarea Philippi (Banyas), the source of the River Jordan. We continue to Cana, Nazareth and the Nazareth Village.

Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 4, Friday

We visit the Mount of Beatitudes which commemorates the Sermon on the Mount, Capernaum “the home town” of Jesus and Tabgha, the site where our Lord feed 5,000 with fives loaves and two fishes. We end the day with a boat trip on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight Tiberias.

Day 5, Saturday

We leave Tiberias and drive to the Baptismal site at Yardenit where there will be opportunity to be baptised in the River Jordan. We then continue along the Jordan Valley to Jericho for a visit. We drive to Masada, Herod’s hilltop

fortress, Ein Gedi and the Dead Sea, where there will be opportunity to bathe. Finally we visit Qumran where a shepherd boy discovered the Scrolls. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Day 6, Sunday

This morning we go to the Garden Tomb to join in the Sunday morning service. Drive to the top of the Mount of Olives and walk down the Palm Sunday road to Dominus Flevit, the Church of All Nations and the Garden of Gethsemane. We then visit St Peter in Gallicantu. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Day 7, Monday

Today we enjoy a walking tour of the Old City. We visit the Temple Mount and walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We end the day with a walk in the Jewish quarter. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Day 8, Tuesday

We drive to Ein Kerem birth place of John the Baptist and then to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and the Shepherds Fields. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem.

Day 9, Wednesday

Free day in Jerusalem. OPTIONAL - Walk through Hezekiah’s tunnel. Bring a torch and clothing that you don’t mind getting wet! Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10, Thursday

Transfer to airport for return flight to London Heathrow.
